

ADMISSION GUIDELINES

Parents/students are requested to go through the Prospectus and the Guidelines and Admission Notices put up on the College Notice Board, before seeking admission in the College. Admission is as per merit and other norms as laid down by the University, the Government or the Management, from time to time. The Principal reserves the right to amend / modify the guidelines regarding admission, as and when such amendments / modifications are received from the Government / University or the Management, as the case may be. The guidelines will be displayed accordingly on the College Notice Board at the time of admission.

- (i) F.Y/S.Y/T.Y admissions will be as per the directions issued by the University of Mumbai from time to time, and subject to availability of seats in the college.
- (ii) A candidate for being eligible for admission to the three year integrated course leading to the Degree of B.COM, BMS, BAF, BBI, B.Sc I.T must have passed the Higher Secondary School Certificate (S.Y.J.C.) Examination conducted by the Maharashtra State Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education, Mumbai or any examination recognized as equivalent, with subjects, as may be specified by the University in Arts, Science or Commerce streams.
- iii) Students passing an examination equivalent to S.Y.J.C. of the Higher Secondary Board Mumbai and Inter-Mediate (Arts/Science/Commerce) of University of Mumbai or from other states & immigrating from other Universities, Boards & seeking admission to the First year of the Three Year Integrated Degree Course will be admitted only on production of a Valid “Provisional Eligibility Certificate” issued by the University of Mumbai for the current academic year and for the desired course. Such students should submit a migration certificate statement of marks and passing certificate in original along with true copies within two months from the date of admission, failing which their admission is liable to be cancelled Such students result will be declared after the Receipt of verification Reports from their Previous Board and Eligibility by Mumbai University. Students are asked to see the University of Mumbai website www.mu.ac.in for various courses and eligibility rules.

- (iv) Students from other colleges seeking admission to the degree college should produce “No objection certificate” from the previous college attended. However their admission will be confirmed only on receipt of the transfer certificate and enrollment confirmation certificate from the previous college.
- (v) All admissions are provisional until confirmed by the appropriate authorities, including previous school/college attended by the student. Students whose admissions are not confirmed before the final examination are liable to lose the attendance kept by them and their admission to college may be cancelled.
- (vi) Those who are desirous of enjoying Leave Travel Concession, i.e. Long Journey Rail Concession, should write their complete Home Town address and nearest railway station in the Admission Form at the time of admission, failing which no application for long jour Railway Concession will be entertained.
- (vii) Documents required at the time of admission :
- 1) Original HSC Marksheet along with two photo copies.
 - 2) Original leaving certificate along with two photo copies.
 - 3) SC/ST/VJ/NT/OBC/EWS students should submit one verified copy of the following documents:
 - a] Caste certificate b] Income certificate-Current Year
 - c] Leaving certificate d] Photo copy of ration card (first and last page).
 - e] Non creamy layer certificate for VJ/NT/OBC/SBC
 - f] Mark Sheet & Board Certificate of 10th & 12th STD
 - 4] Private candidate should submit Xth & XIth Leaving Certificate and letter from the institution from where they have appeared for H.S.C. Examination (Original along with two photocopies).
 - 5) Original copies of necessary proof alongwith two photo copies in case of any other reserved category such as ex-service men, freedom fighter, handicapped students, sports/ cultural achievers etc.
 - 6) True copy of Ration Card or Electricity Bill & Aadhar Card as address proof.
 - 7) Gap Certificate with Notary if Necessary.
 - 8) Migration Certificate if Necessary.
 - 9) Two Passport size photos
 - 10) SC/VJ/NT/OBC/EWS scholarship student open Bank Account in the Nationalise Bank

MODE OF REFUND OF FEES AND DEPOSITS

Refund of Tuition, Development and all other fee after cancellation of admissions :

The candidates who have taken admission in under graduate courses in Government College, in Government aided and recognized Institutions may request for refund of fees after applying in writing for cancellation of their admission to the course. The refund of fees as applicable shall be made on or before 30th day after the date of cancellation and thereafter the percentage of fee of the course shall be refunded to the candidate after deducting charges as follows :

Note : The total amount considered for the refund of fee from the commencement of academic term of the course includes the following :

- i) All the fees items chargeable for one year are as per relevant University of mumbai circulars for different Faculties (excluding the courses for which the total amount is fixed by other competent authorities)
- ii) The Fees charged towards group insurance and all fee components to be paid as per University share (including Vice-Chancellor Fund, University fee for sports and cultural activities, E-charge, disaster management fund, exam fee and Enrollment fee) are non-refundable if payment is made by the college prior to the date of cancellation.
- iii) Fees collected for Identity card and Library card, admission form and prospectus, enrollment and any other course specific fee are not refundable after the commencement of the academic term.

- iv) All refundable deposits (Laboratory, Caution Money and Library etc.) shall be fully returned at the time of cancellation provided that wherever admissions are made through centralized admission process for professional and/or for any other courses by other competent Authorities. The Refund Rules are applicable if specified by such authorities (as per the rules of relevant agencies) for the 1st year admission. In case of admission to subsequent years of the course, 0.2859 is applicable for cancellation of admission. Provided further that this refund rule is concurrent with the rules and guidelines of other professional statutory bodies appointed for admission for relevant courses. Further that 0.2859-A and 0.2859-B have been repealed and amended relating to the refund of Tuition Fees, Development and all other fees after cancellation of admission for the Under Graduate Courses has been brought into force with effect from the academic year 2008-2009.

Refund of deposit only from 15th November to 30th December.

- 1) If a student informs the Principal of the College/Institution, in writing, within 30 days from the date of commencement of the term that he desires to cancel his admission, all fees shall be refunded to him after deduction of Rs. 30/- (Rupees thirty only) as administrative charges.
- i) At the time of applying for admission, he/she intimates in writing, that he/she has also applied or intends to apply for admission to one or more of the professional colleges or Institutions or Departments affiliated to this University which impart instruction for Degree Courses in Engineering, Architecture, Physiotherapy, Occupational Therapy, Audiology & Speech Therapy, Unani Medicine, Homeopathy, Painting, Commercial Art, Home science & Courses conducted by the National Defense Academy or Indian Institute of Technology or Regional Colleges of Engineering.
- ii) He/She withdraws his/her application, within 7 days from the date of his/her admission to a professional college or a course mentioned above but not later than 31st August of the same academic year. In such cases, it shall be binding on the student to produce documentary proof of his/her being admitted to the professional course.
- 2) All fees paid by the student at the time of admission shall be refunded to him/her on production of receipts after deducting Rs.250/- (Rupees two hundred fifty only) or all prescribed fees, whichever is less as administrative charges provided :
- i) At the time of applying for admission, he/she intimates in writing, that he/she has also applied or intends to apply for admission to one or more of the professional colleges or institutions or departments affiliated to this

University which impart instruction for degree course in Engineering, Architecture, Physiotherapy, Occupational Therapy, Audiology & Speech Therapy, Unani Medicine, Homeopathy, Paining, Commercial Art, Home science & Courses conducted by the National Defence Academy or Indian Institute of Technology or Regional Colleges of Engineering and T.Y.B.A/B. Com./B.Sc. Examination Rules.

- ii) He/She withdraws his/her application in writing, within 7 days from the date his/her admission to a professional college or a course mentioned in (1) above, but not later than 30th September of the same academic year. In such cases, it shall be binding on the student to produce documentary proof of his/her being admitted to the professional course.
- iii) Any cancellation after 30th September but before the end of the term, a student will be eligible to receive the share of tuition fee for the second term and the annual examination fee if already paid. The Students will not be eligible for any refund if cancellation/ studies discontinued after the end of first term. Students seeking admission to the Third year should not have ATKT in both F.Y. and S.Y. together. Only those who have cleared ATKT either for F.Y. or S.Y. shall be admitted.

DISCIPLINE: AND CODE OF CONDUCT

Discipline

1. Discipline is the most important part of education. All students are expected to observe rules and regulations currently in force to enable the smooth working of the college.
2. Students are prohibited to do anything inside or outside the college that will interfere with its orderly administration or affect its public image. No outside influence, political or any other should be brought into the college directly or indirectly.

Code of Conduct

Students should observe the following rules and regulations of the College.

1. Students ought to wear their identity cards all throughout the time they are in College premises.
2. The use of mobile phones is strictly prohibited in the College buildings, class rooms & corridors.
3. Video shooting /photography is allowed with the prior permission of the concerned authority.
4. During lecture hours, students should be present in the class. Students should not loiter around College premises. The attendance of the students is regulated by ordinance 0.6086 University of Mumbai.
5. Students are expected to wear decent attire keeping the sanctity of educational institution in mind. Clothing depicting illegal and vulgar suggestions is prohibited.
6. In case of any problem or query, students can approach the Mentor of their class or the Vice-Principals.
7. Students shall not organize on their own picnics, excursions, trips, etc. without prior written permission of the Principal and an undertaking duly signed by the parents /guardians. The College will not be responsible for any of these activities arranged / organized by the students on their own.
8. Students should not write on desks / walls and should help in maintaining the healthy academic environment and neat and clean premises.
9. Students should not cause any willful/negligent damage to College property. Stringent action shall be taken for unruly behavior.
10. Student should not indulge in any activity that would damage or spoil the reputation of the College and Management.

11. Any kind of private celebration, cake cutting etc., is prohibited in the classrooms/campus in order to maintain the cleanliness and academic atmosphere in the institution.
12. Consumption and use of any kind of mind altering substances and tobacco products is prohibited in campus/College Premises.
13. Students must respect their fellow students, teachers, supporting staff and security staff and behave with them with dignity and grace.
14. Students should not cause any type of harm which would cause mental agony and physical trauma to their fellow students and should work towards gender equality.
15. Students are expected to read the College Notice board, College Website (www.anandviswagurukul.com) and Mumbai university Website (www.mu.ac.in) regularly. Ignorance under any circumstances will not be excused.
16. Students should note that copying or attempting to copy, possession of any such material or having adverse influence on his / her fellow students during examination will be treated as an offence according to the rules of University of Mumbai. The Students found to be involved in such unfair incidents will be dealt with strict action. Students should maintain silence and observe all discipline in College premises. And should remain equally committed to the cause of their own personal growth and development and learning.

* **College Norms Regarding Attendance :**

The attendance of the students is regulated by ordinance 6086 of University of Mumbai relating to the attendance for learners

1. Every bonafide learner shall ordinarily be allowed to keep terms for the given semester in program of his enrolment, only if he fulfills at least seventy five percent (75%) of the attendance taken as an average of the total number of lectures, practicals, tutorials etc. wherein short and /or long excursions/field visits/study tours organized by the total number of periods which are otherwise delivered on the material day/s. Further it is mandatory for every learner to have minimum 50% attendance for each course and average attendance has to be 75%.
2. Students who fail to maintain the condition of minimum attendance on account of bonafide illness, or any other reason which is deemed right by the Principal, should apply in writing to the Principal for leave of absence, prior or within 2 days from the date of commencement of such leave, failing which they will be treated as defaulters.
3. All applications for leave of absence along with medical certificate, if any are to be submitted to the Vice-Principals.

BACHELOR OF COMMERCE

Bachelor of Commerce (B.COM.) : Mumbai University Traditional Degree Course.

Three year B.Com Course divided into six semesters. The Degree shall be titled as **Bachelor of Commerce**

Objective

- 1) To create for the students of University of Mumbai an additional avenue of self employment and also to benefit the industry by providing them with suitable trained person in the field of accounting and Insurance.
- 2) To prepare student to exploit opportunities, being newly created, in the accounting and finance profession.
- 3) To provide adequate basic understanding about Commerce educational among the students.
- 4) To give an adequate exposure to operational environment in the field of Commerce.
- 5) To include training and practical approach by using modern technologies amongst the student in the field of Commerce.

Eligibility : for Admission (B.Com.)

- a) A candidate for being eligible for admission to the Bachelor of Commerce Degree Course shall have passed XII std Examination of the Maharashtra Board of Secondary & Higher Education, Pune or its equivalent. **(Repeater are also Eligible)**
- b) Every Candidate admitted to the degree Course in the Constituent/affiliated College recognised institution, conducting the course shall have to register himself/herself with the University.
- c) Students passing an examination equivalent to S. Y. J .C. of the Higher Secondary Board, Mumbai and Inter-Mediate (Science/Commerce) of University of Mumbai or from other states & immigrating from other Universities, Boards & seeking admission to the F.Y. of the Three Year Integrated Degree Course will be admitted only on production of a Valid **“Provisional Eligibility Certificate”** issued by the University of Mumbai for the current academic year and for the desired course. Such students should submit a migration certificate, statement of marks and passing certificate in original along with true copies within two months, from the date of admission, failing which their admission is liable to be cancelled.

- 2) To prepare student to exploit opportunities, being newly created, in the Accounting and Finance profession.
- 3) To provide adequate basic understanding about Accounting and Finance educational among the students.
- 4) To give an adequate exposure to operational environment in the field of accounting and finance.
- 5) To include training and practical approach by using modern technologies amongst the student in the field of Accounting and Finance.

Eligibility : for Admission (B.Com. Accounting and Finance)





Examinations Pattern (Degree College) Scheme of Evaluations

The performance of the learners shall be evaluated in two parts internal assessment with 25 marks by way of continuous evaluation and by semester end assessment with 75 marks by conducting the theory examination.

- I. Internal Assessment: It is defined as the assessment of the learners on the basis of continuous evaluation as envisaged in the credit based system by way of participation of learners in various academic and correlated activities in the given semester of the programme.

LIBRARY

1. Rules and Regulations of the library (for students)

- a. Every individual entering the library should be a BONAFIDES STUDENT of the College and must have a valid IDENTITY SMART CARD. 3. Circulation

- a. Library books are lent to readers for home reading between 2.00 pm to 8.00 pm

Note: For In House Reading, books from Reading Hall as well as Home Lending Section and Reference and Research Section are Provided during all working hours.

4. Library Fine

- a. Books are issued for a period of one week from the Home Lending Section. Books reserved for in-house reading are not allowed to be taken out. A book must be returned on or before the due date shown on the book. In case a student fails to return a book within the time limit, a fine of Re.1 per day per book will be charged for first 15 days and Rs.2/- per day per book after 15 days onwards. During Examination days the fine would be Rs.10/- per day per book. A Student may get a book reissued, if it is not demanded.

5. Mutilation of Books

- a. It is strictly forbidden to mark library books with pencil or ink or mutilate them in any way. The reader to whom the book was/is issued last will be held responsible for loss of pages or any other damage unless he/she has brought it to the notice of the library staff before borrowing. Any student held responsible for damage of reading materials will be liable to fine equivalent to the damage caused.

6. Reading Hall

- Reading hall copies of the books should be used in reading hall only. A student taking books outside the reading hall without the permission of the librarian will have to pay a fine of Rs. 10 per day per book.
- Reserving of seats is not permitted in the reading hall of the library under any circumstance.
- Complete Silence** must be observed in and around the library Disregard of the rule will invite punishment leading to suspension of members.
- Please note that Reading Hall is meant for reading hall of the library under any circumstance.

7. Discipline

- The smooth working of the library is possible only if students adhere to the rules and regulations of the library. The Librarian reserves the right to refer cases of breach of discipline to the Principal.


